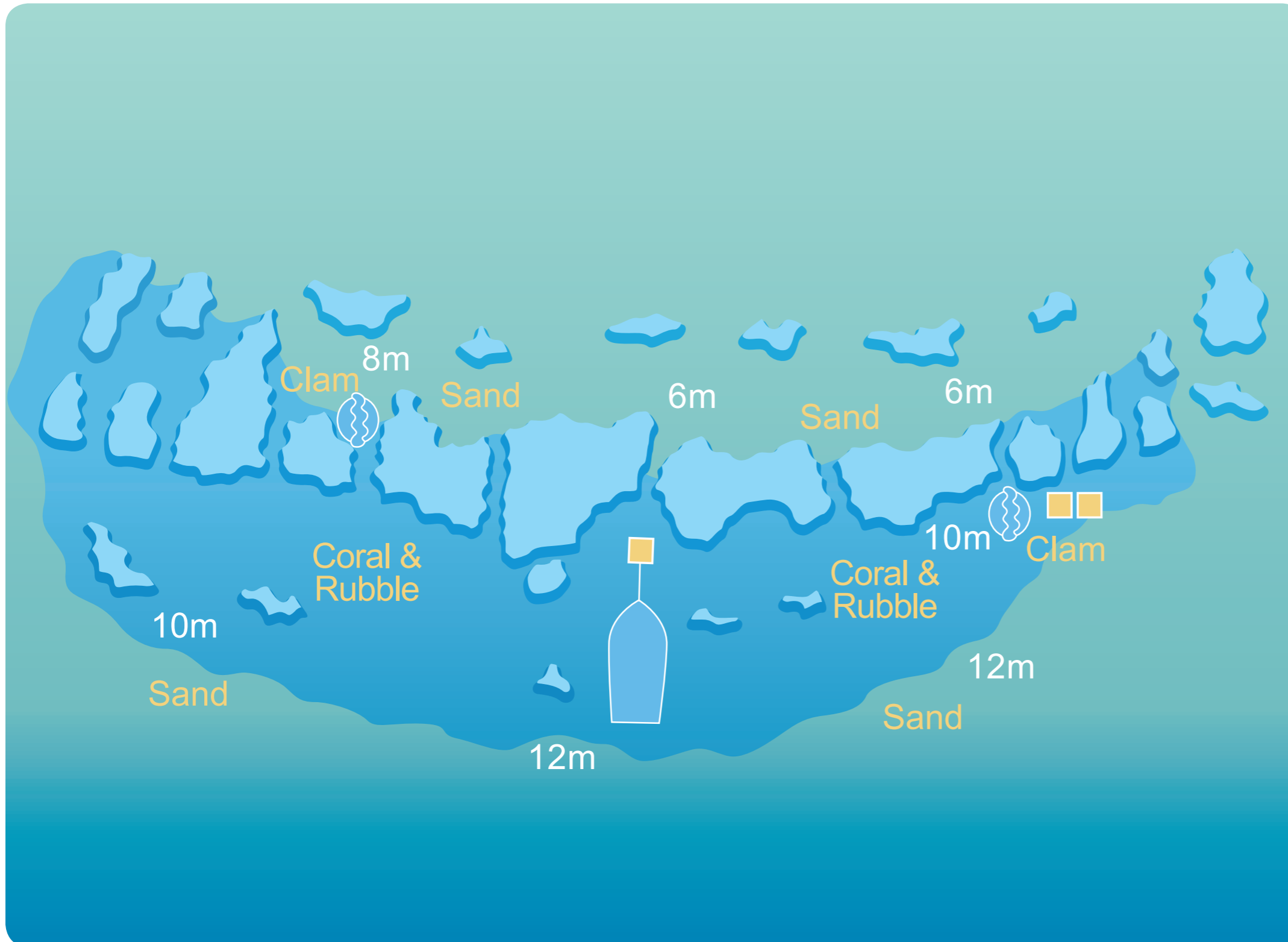

**Site:** This site offers the opportunity to view a large variety of marine life up close and while only a shallow dive, the yellow tail fusiliers that meet you upon entering the water are a delight. Shallow canyons full of fish life lead into a very sheltered area with an abundance of soft corals. Butterfly and angelfish provide plenty of entertainment as they feed. Sweetlip and coral trout frequent the shallow canyons. One of the larger giant clams to be found is at this site.
